










=> Comment choisir la taille de votre casque ?

Vous devez choisir la taille de votre casque en fonction de la dimension de votre tour de tête.



KEP Italia produit des casques avec une coque externe disponible en deux tailles qui donnent lieu à leur tour à toutes les tailles en fonction de l'épaisseur. Il est possible d'insérer 8 tailles différentes (de la 51 à la 58) dans la coque moyenne, tandis que la grande coque accueille celles allant de la taille 59 à la taille 62.

Il est en effet possible d'insérer de petits rembourrages à l'intérieur du casque, afin d'adapter parfaitement celui-ci à la tête du cavalier (qui peut être ovale, ronde ou ovoïde). Ceux-ci peuvent être insérés à l'avant, à l'arrière ou sur les côtés du casque, toujours à l'intérieur du casque. C'est justement à cette fin que KEP Italia a conçu douze rembourrages pour les têtes ovales (typiques en Europe) et douze rembourrages pour les têtes plus étroites (typiques en Amérique du Nord et au Canada).









=> How to choose the size of your helmet?

You must choose the size of your helmet according to the dimension of your head mast.

Take the measurement of your head mast in centimetre. You will be able to then choose the size of the helmet which will be appropriate to you best.

Standards covering Kep Italia CROMO HELMETS

Kep Italia helmets comply with the high safety requirements of the following standards:

1. CE EN 1384:2012 (European Standard):

This standard is recognized by most of the Countries all over the world. Most of the certified helmets have passed this Standard as it is the most requested, except for American and Canadian markets where it is compulsory to ride with the helmets covered by the ASTM F1163. Manufacturers need to have the products certificated SEI.

2. SEI Certification Certified Mode ASTM F1163.04^a (American/Canadian Standard)

Obtained by several controls and tests after several inspections done by SEI inspectors. This Certification is applied to each product and it is a Product Certification.

3. BS EN 1384:2012 KITEMARK Certification

British Standard compulsory for helmets to be used for Ponies Competitions and also suggested for Races.

4. PAS 015:2012 Certification

5. IC Certification EN 1384:2012 (New British Standard):

It is very important to say that your helmet is very safety, but it should be really so. What is very important to observe is how the helmet is covering the head of the rider. Most of the helmets have the rear part that doesn't cover too much the neck and it appears like not to be very protective. It is known that most of the falls are in the front part but it is also recognized that when there is a fall it could be very dangerous for all the head and more the head is protected, more it will be safer for the rider. What Kep Italia has studied is to give more protection but also lightness, comfort, stability and technology. This means to continue to improve a better result giving importance to all details that do of a helmet a Superior Helmet. To obtain the best results in different Standards means to work in a very high level in order to invest in the best material and quality. Quality process and check are very important to be done. They require many investments in terms of controls and persons but they are so important to reach the best results we want to obtain.

As any rider knows, riding is an extreme sport. The KEP ITALIA helmet is safer than other riding helmets because it is designed to provide you with optimum protection.

1) MOULDING SYSTEM

The protective system is based on the principle that the outer shell is moulded with the polystyrene foam inner shell resulting in better absorbing the energy from the impacts and protecting your head from injury as far as possible.

2) DESIGN OF THE HELMET

Rear part of the helmet drops down the head to enhance your personal safety.

3) CHIN-STRAP

With a strong nylon band encased in vegetable-tanned leather, the chin- strap is both secure and smooth to your skin. The leather is Italian, entirely toxin-free and easily washable.

4) LINING

The fitted inner lining of the KEP ITALIA helmet is made from Coolmax®, an active fabric that quickly conducts moisture away. The inner lining can be easily removed and hand washed at up to 30°C.

5) VENTILATION

The KEP ITALIA helmet comes with a unique ventilation system. Air is drawn in through air intakes in the front grille. Air canals cut into the helmet's inner liner conduct warm air away from your head and out through the ventilation aperture in the back of the helmet.

6) WARRANTY

All KEP ITALIA helmets are covered by a two-years manufacturer's warranty.

7) APPLICATIONS

Show jumping, dressage, endurance riding, eventing, pony, trekking, western or recreation riding. It is safe to use in all horse handling activities, even when you are not actually on horseback.

8) CERTIFICATIONS

The helmet is designed and approved by four Certification bodies: European BS EN 1384:1996, British Kitemark BS EN 1384:1997, American SEI ASTM F1163.04a and the latest obtained the British IC MARK EN 1384:1996.
